Alicia G. Garcia, 77, of Napoleon, Ohio passed away on Friday, June 11, 2021. She was born on October 25, 1943 in Corpus Christi, Texas to Felix and Luz (Gutierrez) Gomez. Her father died in service during WWII just when she was an infant. She was raised by her mother Luz and her paternal family. She was a social butterfly and liked the opportunities to connect with friends and others in the community while enjoying a good time. Her favorite hobby was gardening. In her last few years, she was a resident of Northcrest Nursing home, where she made new friends with the residents and

the nursing staff. Alicia adored spending time with her family, especially her grandchildren. She was loved by many and was truly one of a kind. She will be missed tremendously.

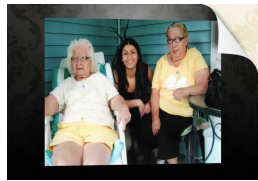
