Walter W. Behnfeldt, 78, of McClure, Ohio died Saturday, January 12, 2013 at CHP Inpatient Hospice in Defiance, Ohio. 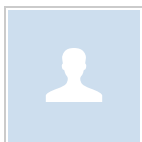
