Winfried W. Bostelman April 25, 1929-February 13, 2009 Winfried William Bostelman, 79, of Deshler, Ohio died Friday evening, February 13, 2009 at the Defiance Area Inpatient Hospice Center. He was born April 25, 1929 in Henry County to the late Fred and Regina (Hoops) Bostelman. On April 17, 1955 he married Margaret Lange at Bethlehem Lutheran Church, Okolona, Ohio and she survives.
