Paul Alfred Bremer, 40, of Hamler, Ohio died Wednesday morning, October 5, 2011 at the Defiance Inpatient Hospice Center, Defiance, Ohio. He was born May 8, 1971 in Defiance to James Alfred and Lois (Rothenberger) Bremer. Paul was a 1990 graduate of Patrick Henry High School and studied Agriculture Business at Owens Community College. For over 18 years, he was a custom applicator at Crop Production Services, Hamler. He had previously worked for Dwight Gerken Farms, Hamler. On August 25, 2000 he married Sue Ann Thomas and they had two sons, Austin and Kaleb; they all survive. He is also survived by his mother, Lois Bremer; sister, Karen Bremer and grandparents, Alfred "Slim" and Evelyn Bremer. He was preceded in death by his father, James.
