



## Dr. Bryan Waggoner III

December 13, 1946 - April 8, 2015

Dr. Bryan L. Waggoner, III, 68, of Wauseon, Ohio died Wednesday, April 08, 2015 at Heartland of Wauseon. He was born December 13, 1946, in Granite City, Illinois to the late Bryan L. Waggoner, Jr., and Carrie Jo Camp. On December 10, 1980, he married Sandra L. Childress, who survives along with his son, Bryan L. Waggoner IV, who is in the U.S. Navy stationed in Denver, Colorado, a brother, Gregory (Ginny) Waggoner, and sisters, Brenda (Don) Koertge and Linda Skillen.

Bryan graduated high school at age 17 and joined the U.S. Navy in 1964, he served as an aviation supply storekeeper, 2nd Class (E-5). He attended Southern Illinois University with degrees in Geography and Psychology; Logan College of Chiropractic with B.S. degrees in Anatomy and Physiology and a Doctorate of Chiropractic. He also received Masters of Science degrees in Biology and Human Nutrition from the University of Bridgeport.

He was a private practice Chiropractor for over 37 years in Arkansas, Oklahoma, and Ohio, spending over 23 years providing service in his Napoleon office. He served on the Oklahoma State Board of Chiropractic Examiners. He also taught at Oklahoma State Community College and Northwest State Community College.

As a fourth generation Mason; he attained the 32nd Masonic degree and served as Master of Napoleon Lodge #256. He was past President of the 5th Masonic District Association, past vice-president of Zenobia Corvairs, past vice-president of Northwest Shrine Club, a member of Hillbilly Clan #75 and

the R.O.J. Toledo Court #21. He was 2005 Potentate of the Zenobia Shrine, and also served on the Board of Governors for Erie - Shriners Hospital for Children.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Monday, April 13th at Rodenberger Funeral Home, Napoleon. Entombment will follow at Riverview Memory Gardens, where military honors will be accorded by the Napoleon Joint Veteran Posts.

Visitation will be held on Sunday from 3-7 p.m. at Rodenberger Funeral Home, Napoleon with a Masonic service held at 6:30 p.m.
