Burdette E. Frysinger, age 92, of Napoleon, passed away on Friday, Jan. 9, 2015, at The Lutheran Home, Napoleon.

He was born in Liberty Township on Oct. 14, 1922, the son of Glen and Vera (Kitter) Frysinger.

Burdette graduated from Liberty Center High School in 1940.
