Carl R. "Butch" Cox, 68, of Grand Rapids, Ohio died on Thursday, July 2, 2020 at the Wood County Hospital. He was born March 29, 1952 in Bowling Green, Ohio to the late Carl E. and Elizabeth (Saunders) Cox.

Carl worked as a chef for over 35 years. He worked for the Maumee Youth Camp, Toledo Correction Center, FiFi's Restaurant, Toledo, and Anthony Wayne Restaurant, Napoleon. He was a member of Grand Rapids Sons of the American Legion and active in the Wood County Senior Center.
