Carol Lee Hoeffel, 77, of Napoleon, Ohio passed away on February 1, 2021 at Hospice of Northwest Ohio. She was born in Liberty Center, Ohio, on July 18, 1943, to Ronald and Marcella (Wilhelm) Osborn. Carol married John “Jack” Hoeffel at St. Augustine Catholic Church in Napoleon, Ohio on November 6, 1965.

Carol worked for the Napoleon City Schools for 20 years in the superintendent’s office. She was a member of St. Augustine Catholic Church, where she served on the Rosary Alter Society and volunteered on several other committees. Additionally, she volunteered for United Way for many years in the residential campaign. Carol enjoyed going to the movies as well as playing Bridge and Scrabble. She liked to tend her garden which provided a place to watch her favorite birds, cardinals and hummingbirds. She enjoyed quiet times at Clear Lake, but her greatest joy was spending time with her family.

Carol is survived by her husband of 55 years, Jack; daughters, Catherine (Michael) Sieber and Amy (Tony) Pfeiffer; grandchildren, Taylor Wagner, Zachary Sieber, Joshua Sieber, Cara Sieber, Drew Pfeiffer, and Eric Pfeiffer;
