August 24, 1936 - January 20, 2022

Carolyn J. Agler, 85, of Florida, Ohio died peacefully on Thursday, January 20, 2022 at CHP Defiance Inpatient Hospice. She was born August 24, 1936 in Holgate, Ohio to the late Henry and Edith (Bost) Lulfs. On February 28, 1958, she married James W. Agler and he preceded her in death on July 5, 2008. Carolyn was a graduate of Holgate High School and the Riverside School of Nursing, Toledo, Ohio. She worked as a nurse for Dr. Francis Lenhart, Henry County Hospital, and retired from Bowling Green State University Health Services.

She was an active member of Florida United Methodist Church, where she taught Sunday school and bible school, member of the pastor/parish committee, sang in the church choir, and co-chaired the annual ice cream social. She served on the 4-H advisory board, Henry County Hospital advisory board, Florida's fireman's auxiliary and various local and state garden clubs. She also volunteered for Henry County United Way, Henry County Heart Association, local American Red Cross chapter; Henry County Cancer Society, where she served on campaigns, as facilitator of the I Can Cope classes, volunteered for Napoleon City schools and was a member of Flying Quail Model A Ford Organization. In 1991, Carolyn was voted Henry County's Woman of the year.

She is survived by her children, Jay (Terri) Agler, Dave (Arlene) Agler, and Penny (Jamie) Henderson; grandchildren, Cody, Tyson, Nick, and Katy; great grandchildren, Bella and Nixon; siblings, Ron (Marie) Lulfs, Bob Lulfs, and

Michael (Marilyn) Lulfs; and sisters-in-law, Carol Agler and Mary Ellen Lulfs. She was also preceded in death by a brother, Gary Lulfs; and sisters-in-law, Joyce Lulfs and Linda Lulfs, and brother-in-law, Thomas Agler.

Funeral services will be held on at 2 p.m. on Monday, January 24th at Florida United Methodist Church, where visitation will be held from 11 a.m. – 2 p.m. Interment will follow at the Florida Cemetery.
