Rita Maxine Cass, 84, of Custar, Ohio died Monday morning, April 27, 2009 at Blakely Care Center of Bowling Green, Ohio. She was born January 28, 1925 in Custar to the late Henry and Matilda (Maas) Metzger. On October 14, 1944 she married Victor L. Cass and he preceded her in death on June 4, 1994. Rita was a 1944 graduate of Milton Township High School. Along with her husband; they had a family farm and then owned and operated the Custar Tavern from 1959-1961. She also drove school bus for the former Westwood Schools and was a homemaker. She was a member of St. Louis Catholic Church, Custar and the Altar & Rosary Society; the Wood County Election Board; Norcross-Meyers American Legion Post #305 Auxiliary, Custar and VFW Post #1148, Bowling Green. Rita was the first woman member of the Custar Village Council and was an avid blood donor with the American Red Cross. Her favorite hobbies included fishing, bowling and playing bingo.
