



Cesilio Cecil Matias

January 30, 1926 - November 29, 2013

Cesilio “Cecil” Matias, 87, of Deshler, Ohio died Friday night, November 29, 2013 at Wood County Hospital, Bowling Green, Ohio.

He was born January 30, 1926 in Utuado, Puerto Rico to Luis Morales Gonzalez and Carmen Matias Colon. At the age of 4, Cecil was orphaned and when he turned 17 he made his own way to the United States and worked hard to become a self made man.
