Chandler Etzler, 19, died unexpectedly on Sunday, December 31 at Henry County Hospital from complications of a congenital heart condition. He was born March 2, 1998 to Kirk and Amy (Cybulski) Etzler.

Chandler was a 2017 graduate of Napoleon High School and attended Four County Career Center. He formerly worked at McDonalds in Napoleon and was last at HOPE Learning Academy of Toledo. 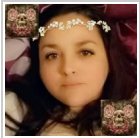
