Arthur H. Chase, 81, of Napoleon, Ohio died Saturday, December 26, 2009 at the Defiance Area Inpatient Hospice. He was born July 2, 1928 in Detroit, Michigan to the late Hasley and Lucy (Harrington) Chase. On July 5, 1968, he married Wanda "Jean" Duff who survives in Napoleon, Ohio. Arthur retired from Local 626. He began his career on February 13, 1957 when he was hired at Campbell Soup; he became the Secretary-Treasurer of the former Local 146 on February 1, 1968 and held this position until June 1, 1982. Art was the 2nd Vice-President of the merged organization. He maintained that office until his retirement. Art's allegiance to the union movement and his belief in what it represented were the foundation of his career in labor. He was affiliated with the St. Paul United Methodist Church in Napoleon.
