Cheryl Lee Winch, 51, of McClure, Ohio, died Thursday, August 7, 2014 at the University of Michigan Hospital in Ann Arbor, Michigan after a long and brave battle with cancer. She was born September 16, 1962 in Napoleon, Ohio to the late Robert "Pete" and Shirley (McClure) Chamberlin. On January 11, 1985, she married Timothy Winch, who survives in McClure.

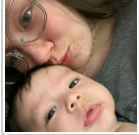

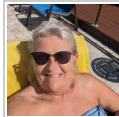
