



## Chester Brenneman

August 20, 1943 - December 9, 2015

Chester L. Brenneman, 72, of McClure, Ohio died Wednesday, December 9, 2015 at Wood County Hospital in Bowling Green. He was born August 20, 1943 in Toledo to the late Myron & Lena (Shank) Brenneman. On September 2, 1969, he married Bonnie Spangler, who survives.

Chet worked for Temcole Radish Factory, McClure for over 20 years and 13 years at Gilson Machine, Napoleon until he retired. He served in the U.S. Army and was a member of the McClure American Legion and Leipsic VFW. He was a dedicated member of St. Paul Lutheran Church, McClure where he was a former member of church council and Sunday school Superintendent. He was a former Chairman of McClure Radish festival. He enjoyed fishing, bowling, and was an avid Detroit Tigers fan. He loved rooting on the McClure Pony League baseball team and was considered their #1 fan!

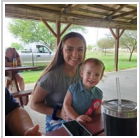
