Maurice "Mort" Cordes, 77, of Napoleon, OH died Monday, July 27, 2009 at his residence. He was born June 22, 1932 in Napoleon to the late Theodore & Dorothy (Drewes) Cordes. 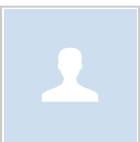
