Dave Rohrbaugh, 65, of Napoleon, Ohio died Wednesday, September 23, 2020 at CHP Defiance Area Inpatient Hospice. He was born November 28, 1954 in Napoleon to the late Donald and Bonnie (Bachtol) Rohrbaugh. On November 4, 1983, he married Mary (Fiser) Rohrbaugh.

Dave was a 1973 graduate of Patrick Henry High School, where he was a letterman in baseball and basketball. He worked for GM Powertrain in Defiance from 1973-2006. He was one of the founders of Napoleon Diamond Boosters, organized many baseball fundraisers and was instrumental in helping build the Napoleon football stadium. He enjoyed watching his kids and grandkids play sports and spent many hours with his new grandbaby, Ava. He looked forward to family vacations at Myrtle Beach and spent as much time as he could with them. He also loved taking his dogs, Buddy and Bailey for adventures and watching Ohio State Football.
