David was born on December 29, 1950, in McKeesport, PA, to parents Joseph and Joan. He is survived by sons, Anthony and Christopher; daughter-in-law, Sarah; grandsons, Connor and Michael; sisters, Judy, Nancy Cracolice, Kathy Partridge; and brother, Robert. He was also an avid photographer and enjoyed taking pictures of National Monuments and historic sites. He was a devout fan of Pittsburgh sports, especially the Steelers, Pirates, and Panthers. David also enjoyed traveling, walking, classic rock and technology. Most of all, he treasured time with his family and being "Baboo" to his grandsons.

David is Baptized into the name of Jesus Christ and clung to His promises throughout his earthly life. He began life in the Catholic Church before converting to the Lutheran Church in 1983 and remained a member of St. Paul Lutheran in Napoleon where he served various roles as usher, treasurer, congregational chair, and elder until his death. Dying in Christ, David lives now in the presence of his Savior, resting from his labors and awaiting the resurrection of the dead and a joyous reunion with us in Paradise.

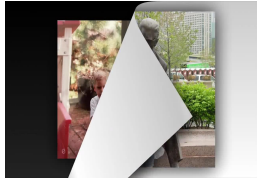
