David Ross Marshall, 78, of Deshler, Ohio passed away Monday morning, May 4, 2015 at the Bridge Hospice Care Center, Bowling Green, Ohio. He was born May 6, 1936 in Buffalo, New York to the late Robert and Mary (McMahon) Marshall.

David graduated in 1954 from Boys Vocational High School, Buffalo, New York. He then honorably served with the U.S. Army during the Korean War. He worked as the manager of Shea's Buffalo Theater where he met Patricia Haffner. On September 9, 1961 he married Patricia at St. Aloysius Church, Cheektowaga, New York.

David worked for Buffalo Civic Auto Ramps for over 42 years, retiring in 2000. Him and Patricia then moved to Deshler where he worked for over 10 years for the Henry County Transportation Network.
