



## Delores "Dee" Zachrich

February 28, 1928 - May 28, 2022

Delores Cecilia "Dee" (Bohn) Zachrich, 94, of Napoleon, Ohio died Saturday, May 28, 2022 at the Van Wert Manor in Van Wert, Ohio.

She was born February 28, 1928 in Defiance, Ohio to the late Louis and Alice (Shumaker) Bohn. On January 18, 1948 she married Rollen "Ron" Zachrich.
