



## Dennis Dale Meyer

July 26, 1951 - September 26, 2023

Dennis Dale Meyer, 72, of Ridgeville Corners, Ohio, died unexpectedly on Tuesday, September 26, 2023, at his residence. He was born on July 26, 1951, to Maynard H. and Lucille Anna (Otte) Meyer. He was baptized, confirmed, and was a current member of Zion Lutheran Church in Ridgeville Corners. He graduated in the last graduating class from Ridgeville Corners in 1969 and earned a bachelor's degree in political science from Northwestern University in Evanston, Illinois.

Denny is survived by his siblings: Douglas Meyer (Patricia) of State College, PA, David Meyer (Kirsten), and Diann Meyer-Grieser (Todd) of Ridgeville Corners; nephew, Brice (Tracy) Meyer; and great-nephew, Barrett, and great-niece, Violet.

In his younger years, Denny spent a good amount of time on the golf course with his friends and was quite the competitor. He was proud to be a Ridgeville Falcon and represented the school through a variety of sports and music. He was happy to carry on the legacy of Meyer Farm Service, which was established in 1942 by his father and uncle, and in 1985, Denny and his brother Dave, took over ownership and formed Meyer Equipment. Denny loved every opportunity he had to visit with family and friends and especially enjoyed the time spent with his great-niece and nephew at family gatherings and during their VBS and church events.

A memorial service will be held at 11 a.m. on Monday, October 2, 2023, at Zion Lutheran Church in Ridgeville Corners, Ohio, with Rev. Carl Rockrohr officiating. Interment will follow in the church cemetery.

A memorial gathering will be held from 1-5 p.m. on Sunday, October 1, at Rodenberger-Gray Funeral Home in Napoleon, and on Monday from 10-11 a.m. at the church.

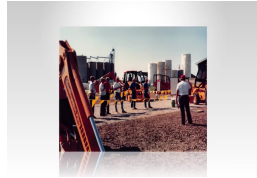
