Shirley Y. Dietrich , 87 , of Malinta, Ohio passed away quietly May 10, 2013 at Henry County Hospital of Napoleon, Ohio surrounded by her loving family. She served on the Christian Education Board, was a Youth Advisor, Sunday School teacher, a member of the Visitation Team, and was a Church Elder for 6 years. She loved to read, fish, dance and spend summers with family and friends at her cottage on Mullet Lake, Michigan, where she taught her grandchildren and great-grandchildren to water ski. She is survived by daughters, Jane Brent of Napoleon and Kathy "Taff" (Sam) Cline of Delta; grandchildren, Pete (Stacy) Brent of Malinta, Robin (Jim) Foster of Liberty Center; great-grandchildren, Evan, Zachary and Riley Brent, Jesse and David Foster. She was also preceded in death by her son, Jim Dietrich, son-in-law, Dale Brent, and granddaughters, Victoria Y. Foster and
