Donald Hahn, 88, of Deshler, Ohio died peacefully on Thursday, May 23rd, 2019 at CHP Defiance Area Inpatient Center. Don was born July 26th, 1930 at his home in Hamler, Ohio to the late Emil and Augusta (Spoering) Hahn. On May 8, 1952 he married Mildred (Tietje) Hahn at St. John Lutheran Church, Deshler, Ohio.

Don helped build the Campbell Soup Plant in Napoleon and after it was constructed, he operated its laundry department for over 35 years. After retirement he worked part-time for the Graminex Company.
