Donald August Hoops, 91, of Deshler, Ohio passed away Friday, February 16, 2018 at the Southern Arizona Veterans Healthcare Hospital, Tucson, Arizona. Don had moved to be closer to his daughter this past year.

He was born January 5, 1927 in Deshler to the late Samuel and Emma (Fintel) Hoops. On November 7, 1948 he married Mildred "Millie" (Firman) Hoops and they shared over 66 years together before she preceded him in death on July 10, 2015.
