Donald George Schuette, 88, of Napoleon, Ohio died peacefully on Monday, May 16, 2016 at the Orchards of Northcrest. He was born April 27, 1928 in Napoleon Township, Ohio to the late George and Wilhelmina (Rickenberg) Schuette. On March 20, 1949, he married Ramona Deming at St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Napoleon Township, Ohio.

Don was a dedicated businessman in the local community for over 57 years. It all began in 1953 when Don opened Schuette TV and Appliance, added Schuette Piano and Organ Center in 1973, and a Radio Shack dealership in 1976. In 1978, he combined the businesses into Omni Electronics, which he owned and operated until he retired in 2010.

He was Past President of the Napoleon Chamber of Commerce Retail Division, Past President of Full Gospel Businessmen's Fellowship, Napoleon Chapter, member of the Gideon's International, and served as a volunteer fireman for the Napoleon Fire Department.

He is survived by his wife, Ramona; children, Greg (Lori) Schuette of Napoleon, and Marsha Schuette of Martinez, California; grandchildren, Jeffrey Schuette of Holland, Michigan, and Jennifer (Zachary) Holland of Edmund, Oklahoma; and 2 great grandsons. He was preceded in death by sister, Mildred Huner; brother, Elmer Schuette, and infant brother, Alfred Schuette.
