



Donald Wesley Slight

December 18, 1944 - January 20, 2024

Donald “Don” Wesley Slight, 79, of Napoleon, Ohio, died on January 20, 2024, at the Toledo Hospital. He was born in Napoleon on December 18, 1944, to Roy and Anna (Clausen) Slight. Don was a 1963 graduate of Napoleon High School, where he proudly played football under Charles Buckenmeyer. After graduation, he spent his career as a heavy equipment operator at various companies such as Miller Bros. Construction, Vernon Nagel Inc., and E.S. Wagner. Don was baptized, confirmed and a lifelong member of St. Paul Lutheran Church Napoleon, where he married Catherine “Suzi” Ludeman on June 27, 1964, in the church parsonage.

Throughout his life, Don was an avid outdoorsman and member of Maumee Valley Sportsman Club. He enjoyed riding four wheelers, hunting woodchucks, and camping. Don also loved cheering for two football teams - the Napoleon Wildcats and the Ohio State Buckeyes. Many of these cheers involved language that cannot be printed here. He loved his dogs, and was often seen driving around Napoleon with them riding shotgun in his pickup truck.

He had a way with words and a fondness for desserts, which his family will continue to enjoy in memory of him. Don loved his family, especially his grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

He is survived by his loving wife, Suzi; children, Todd (Carol) Slight, Jerry

(Kitty) Slight and Theresa (Kurt) Wilhelm; 8 grandchildren; 2 great-grandchildren; and sister, Karen (Marty) Hogrefe. In addition to his parents, Don was preceded in death by siblings, Richard "Dickie" Slight, Dorothy Armey, Robert "Bob" Slight, Marcille Eberle, and Maxine Judon.

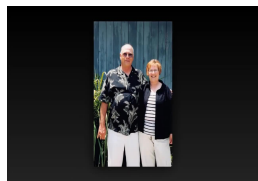
