Doris Mabel Beck, 90, of Ridgeville Corners, Ohio passed away on Wednesday, April 21, 2021. She was born in Toledo, Ohio on June 15, 1930 to Raymond and Mabel (Riester) Adams. She married John Thomas Beck on August 22, 1959 at St. Richard's Catholic Church in Swanton, Ohio.
