Edward Harry Meister of Liberty Center, Ohio died peacefully, after a brief illness at St. Luke's Hospital on December 26, 2017 in Maumee, Ohio at the age of 83.

Ed is survived by his beloved wife of 62 years, Aunalee Bard Meister, Liberty Center, Ohio; his three children, Brad (Kathy) Meister, Lori (Mark) Johnston, and Tim (Karen) Meister; He is also survived by seven grandchildren, three great grandchildren, five step-grandchildren, eight step-great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.
