Edwin A. Baden, 93, of Malinta, Ohio passed away on Wednesday, August 30, 2017 at Genacross Lutheran Services - Napoleon Campus. He was born July 9, 1924 to the late Carl and Elizabeth (Vogel) Baden. He married Loma (Browning) Baden on December 3, 1943 and she preceded him in death in 2002.

Ed started working in metal fabrication at Standard Metal and then became instrumental in helping start Glison Screen, Inc. in Malinta and continued there until his retirement. He was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Malinta. He served in the United States Army during WWII.

Ed will be remembered for his John Deere riding mower, as he used it for transportation as well as keeping his yard manicured for several years.

He is survived by his children, Judith (Monte) Moore of Holgate, Ohio, Pat Hoffman (Jim Young) and Rick Baden (Jeanne Repass), both of Malinta, Ohio; 14 grandchildren; 26 great grandchildren, 2 great great grandchildren; and sister, Ruth (Stan) Moll of Napoleon, Ohio. He was also preceded in death by his son, Terry "T-Bone" Baden and sister, Olga Erford.

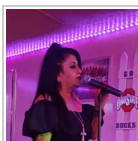
