Elden A. Meyer, 90, of Napoleon, passed away Wednesday, April 19, 2023 at Swanton Valley Care Center.

Elden was the oldest of three boys of Arnold and Marie (Riebesel) Meyer. He was born on the family farm in Napoleon township on February 23, 1933. On November 9, 1968, he married Janet Gillen at St. Mary's Catholic Church, Assumption, Ohio.

Elden was a 1951 graduate of Napoleon High School. He was drafted into the United States Army and served two years in Kirch-Gons, Germany where he established lifetime friendships. After his discharge, he started working for Okolona Lumber, where he learned the trade of cabinet making and carpentry. In 1967 he started the Meyer Cabinet Shop. He specialized in cabinet making, remodeling, and also built some new homes. He enjoyed his animals and flower gardens.

Elden was a lifelong member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Napoleon Township and served on their cemetery board. He was a member of Ohio Farmers Union, a 4-H advisor, a Napoleon Township Trustee, and belonged to the Northwest Ohio Township Association and the Napoleon American Legion Post #300.

He is survived by his wife of 54 years, Janet; children, Sherri (Brent) Short, Napoleon, Tim (Nichole) Meyer, Ft Wayne, and Andrea Meyer, Columbus; granddaughter, Madelyn, Ft. Wayne; and nieces, Kelly (Fred) Roessler, Karen (Glen) Rettig, and Anne Dechiro; and a sister-in-law, Dora (Meyer) Feffer. He was preceded in death by his parents, and brothers, Harlan and Maurice (Diane).

Funeral Service for Elden will be held on Sunday, April 23 at 3 p.m. at St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Napoleon Township. The visitation will be held from 1-3 p.m. prior to the funeral. Military honors will be accorded by the Bert G. Taylor American Legion Post 300 of Napoleon following the funeral. Interment will be held privately on Monday.
