Thomas Eldor Elling, 63, of Wauseon, Ohio died Thursday, August 8, 2013 at Regency Hospital, Sylvania, Ohio. He was born March 11, 1950 in Napoleon, Ohio to Eldor and Marcile "Sally" (Nye) Elling.
