Ervin R. Meyer, 89, of Napoleon, Ohio, formerly of Hamler, died Friday, December 29, 2017 at Genecross Lutheran Services - Napoleon Campus. He was born June 25, 1928, in Bartlow Twp., Ohio to the late Rudolph and Alvina (Bartels) Meyer. On September 24, 1950, he married Louise (Rauch) Meyer at St. Paul Lutheran Church, Napoleon, Ohio.

Erv was a lifelong farmer and was proudly inducted into the Henry County Agriculture Hall of fame in 2012. He has always been active in the farming community and served on both, Henry County and local Agriculture Extension committees. He was Past President, Vice President and Secretary of Henry County Soil and Water Board, member of District Water Board, State of Ohio Soil and Water Commission, Ohio Federation of Soil and Water Conservation Supervisors Hall of Fame, Ohio Vegetable Growers Association, and assisted in creating Ag Credit.

He was a lifelong member of Immanuel Lutheran Church, Hamler and lately attended St. Paul Lutheran Church, Napoleon. He served as Elder, President, Vice President, and Secretary of Immanuel Lutheran Church. He helped organize Henry County United Way and served on the first Board of Directors, served on Hamler School PTA and member of Patrick Henry Athletic Boosters, and served on Henry County Board of Elections.

He served as a Corporal in the U.S. Army from 1953-1957 and was a member of Hamler American Legion and Napoleon VFW.

He is survived by his loving wife of 67 years, Louise, children; Bruce (Konnie)

Meyer of Hamler, Sandra Rollins of Napoleon, and Pamela (Jeff) Pflum of Homosassa, Florida, 10 grandchildren, and numerous great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his son, Randall Lee, son-in-law, Tony Rollins, brothers, Raymond and Donald Meyer, and sister, Juanita Petersen.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. on Tuesday, January 2, at Immanuel Lutheran Church, Hamler. Interment will follow at the church cemetery. Military honors will be accorded by the Hamler American Legion.

Visitation will be held on Monday, January 1 from 2-5 p.m. at Rodenberger Funeral Home, Napoleon and Tuesday 10-11a.m. at the church.
