Evelyn F. Rodenberger, 92, of McClure, Ohio died peacefully on Tuesday, November 15, 2016 at the Napoleon Lutheran Home. She was born on January 19, 1924 to the late Willard Dewey and Leisle Frances (Watson) Shriner in Lima, Ohio. She married Clarence "Bud" Rodenberger on July 23, 1948, in Kentucky and he preceded her in death on July 23, 2005.

Evelyn was a member of the United Methodist Church in McClure and the Rebecca Circle. She was a member of the Order of the Eastern Star Chapter 68 of Deshler, a former past matron for Pacific Chapter OES and past matron of the Deshler Chapter. She was also a retired member of the McClure Ladies Auxillary.

Evelyn helped her husband in the operations of the Rodenberger Funeral Home in McClure since 1959 and Deshler from 1968, before retiring in 1987, then worked on a part time basis. She loved and lived the business with her devoted husband, Bud. She also worked a few years for the Farmers State Bank in McClure between 1970 to 1980. As a young adult she sang in a ladies quartet that traveled around to many different places. She also was a wonderful homemaker and mother and grandmother to her family offering a lifetime of love.

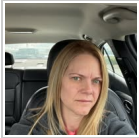
