Warren L. Ferguson February 13, 1931-April 7, 2011 Warren L. Ferguson, 80, of Deshler, Ohio died Thursday morning, April 7, 2011 at Blanchard Valley Hospital, Findlay, Ohio. He was born February 13, 1931 in North Baltimore, Ohio to the late Allen and Marie (Mercer) Ferguson. On August 17, 1954 he married Twila Hungerford in Auburn, Indiana and she survives. Warren was a 1951 graduate of North Baltimore High School and proudly served with the U.S. Marines Corps during the Korean War. Warren was the president of Cast Metals, Inc. of Deshler, retiring after 49 years. He was a member of the American Foundrymen's Society and the Deshler American Legion Post #316.
