Harold "Skeet" Franz January 5, 1921 - April 18, 2012 Harold "Skeet" Franz, 91, of Deshler, Ohio died Wednesday evening at the Bridge Hospice Care Center, Findlay, Ohio. He was born January 5, 1921 in rural Deshler to the late George Ferdinand and Clara (Meyer) Franz. On October 18, 1946 he married Frances M. Harris and she preceded him in death on June 8, 2001. Skeet was a 1938 graduate of Deshler High School. He was a World War II Veteran of the U.S. Army, serving overseas at the same time as all four of his brothers. Along with his wife, they owned and operated Franz Petroleum, Deshler since 1951 and Sunny Shores Haven in Curtis, Michigan since 1963.
