Fritz Hartman, 76, of Malinta, Ohio died unexpectedly on Saturday, June 20th, 2020. Fritz was born on August 12, 1943 in Malinta, Ohio to the late Harley and Alvina (Peper) Hartman. 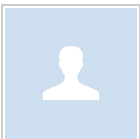
