Genevieve Hoy, 96, of Napoleon, Ohio died peacefully on Friday, September 11, 2015 at Orchards of Northcrest. She was the adopted daughter of Wallace and Ethel Kellogg and grew up in West Unity.

She graduated from Bowling Green State University and taught Business Education at Napoleon High School. She married Walter L. Hoy in 1944 in El Paso, Texas and worked as a secretary for the Superintendent of the El Paso School District. After World War II they returned to Napoleon where she taught until her children were born. After her children were old enough, she worked and retired from the Henry County Clerk of Courts office.

She was a member of the First Presbyterian Church, Napoleon, where she served as a Sunday School teacher and a deacon. In 1973, while serving as Deacon, she was instrumental in the establishment of the local Meals On Wheels program. She was also a member of Sorosis, Browsers Literary Society, and belonged to several bridge clubs.

She is survived by two sons, John Walter Hoy of Napoleon and Timothy James Hoy of Santa Monica, California. She was preceded in death by her husband, Walter, son, Thomas Nathan, and adopted brother, Lon Kellogg. A memorial visitation will be held on Wednesday, Sept. 16 from 4-7 p.m. at Rodenberger Funeral Home, Napoleon. Please dress casual. Interment will be held privately at a later date.
