Geraldine "Geri" M. Haase, 99, of Napoleon, Ohio died peacefully on December 6, 2019 at Alpine Village, Napoleon, Ohio surrounded by her family. She was born March 26, 1920 in Holgate, Ohio to the late Albert and Rosina M. (Zachrich) Groll. On June 23, 1937 she married Lawrence R. Haase in Lima, Ohio and he preceded her in death on June 27, 2000.

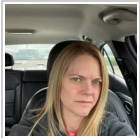
