Gregory L. Wesche, 65, of Napoleon, passed away early Friday morning December 22, 2017 in his home with family.

Greg was born April 16, 1952 to Charles and Virginia (Layman) in Wauseon, Ohio. He attended Ridgeville Schools until his senior year, graduating from Archbold High School in 1970. On March 21, 1986, he married Mary Daman, who survives.

Greg had a teaching career spanning 35 years. He worked for the Maumee Youth Camp, the Alternate Learning Center (Toledo), and ended his educational journey with the Four County Career Center, where following retirement, he continued to substitute teach until this past October. Greg enjoyed travelling with his family, playing golf with friends, watching the Indians win, and he remained hopeful he would see the Browns snap their losing streak. He also loved taking walks with Sadie through town and along the river. In 1971, Greg coached the Archbold Legion baseball team to a State Championship.

Greg is survived by his wife of 31 years, Mary; daughter Gretchen, Napoleon; son Sam, Swanton; brother Larry (Sue), Napoleon; and sister Deb Schnitkey, Pickerington. He also enjoyed spending time with his nieces, nephews, great nieces and great nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents Charles and Virginia, and well loved uncle Wilbur ("Weeb").
