Harold R. Willeman, 96, of Napoleon, Ohio passed away on Tuesday, July 23, 2019. He was the last child born to Martin and Florence (Davis) Willeman in Ridgeville Twp. On August 23, 1922. He attended Liberty Center High School and graduated from Napoleon High School where he lettered in football and track.

Harold was a World War II veteran who enlisted in the Army Air Corps in 1942 and served until the war ended in 1946. He married Martha (Rauch) on December 26, 1947 and she preceded him in death on January 15, 2019.

He was a member of the International Brotherhood of Teamsters for 25 years. Harold was also a member of the Masonic Blue Ridge Lodge in Napoleon and a 32nd degree member of the Scottish Rite, Valley of Toledo. He was an active member of the American Legion Post 300 where he served on the Honor Guard, was a service officer and 3rd Vice Commander. Harold also belonged to the VFW 8218 of Napoleon and was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church, Napoleon.
