



## Helberg Malcolm Sonny

Malcolm G. "Sonny" Helberg, 75, of Napoleon, Ohio died Monday, January 14th, 2008 at the Lutheran Home in Napoleon, Ohio. He was born December 26, 1932 in Napoleon Township to the late Alvin W. & Mildred ( Schroeder) Helberg. On January 5, 1952 he married Rosella (Gerken) Helberg at the St. John Lutheran Church Freedom Township of Napoleon, Ohio, who survives. Sonny worked for C.F.
