Herbert "Herb" William Fuhrhop, 81, of Hamler, Ohio died Tuesday, May 6, 2014 at VanCrest Nursing Home, Holgate.

Herb was born in Marion Township, Ohio on April 22, 1933, the son of William and Sophia (Gobrogge) Fuhrhop. He attended Hamler High School. On September 7, 1958 he married Ruth Behrman, who survives.
