Norman "Oz" Hill April 3, 1929 - November 12, 2012 Norman "Oz" Hill, 83, of Deshler, Ohio died Monday, November 12, 2012 at Wood County Hospital, Bowling Green, Ohio. He was born April 3, 1929 in Deshler to John and Maud (Rickard) Hill. On September 19, 1953 he married Betty (Weimer) Hill at Zion Lutheran Church, Garrett, Indiana. Norm was a 1947 graduate of Deshler High School and then worked for the B & O Railroad. He then served in the U.S. Army for 2 years during the Korean War.
