Robert "Wimp" Hogrefe July 1, 1935-June 27, 2012 Robert "Wimp" Hogrefe, 76, of Deshler, Ohio died Wednesday morning, June 27, 2012 at Oak Grove Healthcare Center, Deshler. He was born July 1, 1935 in Deshler to the late Fred and Meta (Koehnke) Hogrefe. On December 15, 1965 he married Mayver Straley in Leipsic, Ohio and she survives.
