Roger A. Hurst, 51, of rural Archbold, Ohio died Tuesday, July 29, at the Defiance Inpatient Hospice Center in Defiance, Ohio. He was born July 21, 1957 in Napoleon, Ohio to the late Raymond Hurst and Dorothy (Shibler) Hurst who survives in Defiance, Ohio. On May 12, 1979, he married Becky Eberle at St. John United Church of Christ in Holgate, Ohio, and she survives. Roger was a mechanic at Sauder Woodworking in Archbold and previously an employee for Snyder Chevrolet in Napoleon and Christy's Chevrolet in Archbold. He was a 1976 Graduate of Tinora High School. Roger was a member of St. John Lutheran Church, Stryker, where he served as a trustee. He was preceded in death by his father. Funeral services will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Friday, August 1, at St. John Lutheran Church, corner of Rt 6 and 66, Stryker, Ohio officiating Pastor Dale Kern.
