Gordon D. Jameson, 80, of Napoleon, Ohio died peacefully on Saturday, October 2nd, 2010 at the St. Luke's Hospital in Maumee, Ohio after a month long battle with cancer. He was born January 22, 1930 in Rimer, Ohio to the late Eugene & Blanche (Seitz) Jameson. On June 20, 1954, he married Colleen Bryan in Vaughnsville, Ohio, who survives. Gordon was an industrial engineer for the Campbell Soup Co. He was instrumental in starting up the Godiva Chocolate operation in Pennsylvania and the Prego line and all glass manufacturing for the Napoleon plant. He was an electronics technician in the United States Navy and a graduate of The Ohio State University with a bachelor's degree in Industrial Engineering. He was a member of the St. Paul United Methodist Church and the Bert G. Taylor American Legion Post# 300, both of Napoleon; and also Road Trek International RV Group. Gordon had a passion for gardening and will be remembered for his great tomatoes. Also surviving are his two sons. Gregory of Napoleon and Andrew of Vaughnsville, Ohio; grandsons, Alex, Benjamin, and Cory; sisters, Shirley (Jess) Honse and Barbara (Jack) Frost, both of Findlay, and a brother, Donald (Glenna) Jameson of New Braunsville, Texas. He was preceded in death by an infant daughter, Lynn Ann. Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. on Wednesday at the Rodenberger Funeral Home in Napoleon with Pastor Lindy Maurice-Saum officiating. Interment will follow at the Glenwood Cemetery where military honors will be accorded by the Napoleon Joint Veteran Posts.
