Jan D. Snyder, 85, of Toledo, Ohio, formerly of Holgate, Ohio died Thursday, February 11, 2021 at the Flower Hospital.

Jan was born November 19th, 1935 in Holgate to the late Chet and Virginia (Zachrich) Snyder. He graduated from Holgate High school in 1954.
