Martha “Jane” Alspaugh, of McClure, Ohio passed away on her 89th birthday, August 12, 2021. She was born in McClure on August 12, 1932, to Roy and Esther (Brown) Alspaugh.

Jane graduated from McClure Local in 1950 and BGSU in 1962 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Education. She was a fourth-grade teacher for 40 years and team taught at Newbury Local in Geauga County; Southeast Consolidated in Portage County, and Willard City in Huron County. Jane also taught English as Second Language and GED classes at night. She was a member of the McClure United Methodist Church, McClure American Legion Auxiliary, Henry County Retired Teachers, and the Northwest Ohio Emmaus Community.
