It was watching the same favorite collection of VHS tapes on Grandma's TV over and over, or watching Mom and Dad's inner competitive children come out while playing Warlords on the old Atari in Grandma's basement against Uncle Nick & Uncle Pat, and sometimes-- through some fluke, or perhaps generational arrogance on the part of Mom, Dad, & the Uncles, us kids would taste sweet victory and destroy our rivals. A yearly summer trip to visit family in Ohio always meant staying at Grandma & Grandpa Claussen's place, where all these most comforting, wonderful childhood memories were made. Grandma made this space for family visits, where the Claussens could all come together, and I am so grateful for the person she was in my life. I love you Grandma, and Ania and I send all of our love to those of you able to make it this week to Ohio. Stay healthy & safe, and if you can, take some time for yourself and breathe.
