Jerry B. Busby, 83, of Napoleon, passed away Monday, April 9, 2018 at Ebid Hospice, Sylvania, Ohio. He was born on August 14, 1934 in Dover, Ohio to Jay and Pauline (Espenschied) Busby.

Jerry was a 1952 graduate of Dover High School. In 1956 he received his Bachelors of Science in Business Administration from The Ohio State University.
